Busy times at Palmira. Palmira residents and their guests please be alert to the need for all of us to watch for pedestrians, golf carts, bicyclists, joggers, and pet walkers during our busy season.

Palmira MHOA has put up safety crossing signs to further alert vehicles and others to main road traffic areas.
