Visits took place this month -

Friday Night, September 4
Friday Night, September 11
Friday Night, September 25

Summary of Visit – A thorough inspection of the HOA's common grounds (streets and amenity areas throughout Palmira) took place for the removal of the invasive Cane toads. **There was an estimated count of 250-260 Cane toads removed throughout this month.** We highly recommend that Owners keep lights off at night, or switch to bug lightbulbs. This will help keep the Cane toads from hanging out close to homes, under lights. Pictures below, invoice attached.

**Native Southern Toads are present in this community as well; not all are Cane Toads. We remove the Cane toads only and will leave native species and tree frogs.

Now that the rainfall is starting on a regular basis, the toads do not need the lakes for their water source and can venture further into the streets and HOA sides. We always recommend pet owners are vigilant when walking pets outside.
